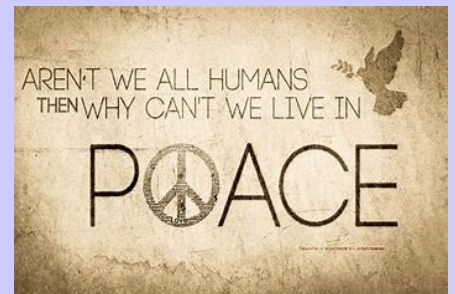
Diversity Day

As you will be aware Snapchat is a platform for users at least 13 years old.
