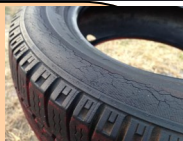

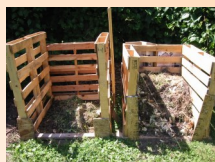
If you could choose one thing to change about the world what would it be?
