As we continue to grow as a school family and in our quest to establish parental involvement, we would like to welcome ALL parents to our Friday Celebration Worships which will remain

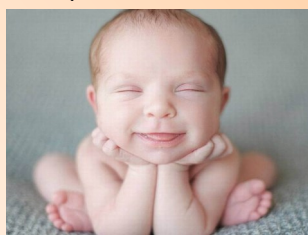
