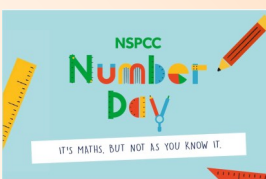

Confirmation Classes.

Is your child currently in Year 6? If so are they interested in getting Confirmed? In the Church of England, Confirmation marks the point in the Christian journey when a person affirms the faith into which they have been baptised and their intention to live a life of committed discipleship. This affirmation is confirmed through prayer and the laying on of hands by the confirming bishop. The Church also asks God to give the person power through the Holy Spirit.

If your child is in Year 6 and wishes to be confirmed they will need to attend Confirmation Preparation Sessions led by Rev'd Kat and Nigel Baldwin. These sessions will take place on Wednesday 5th February at 6:15pm for six weeks onwards.
