to the end of term on Friday 4th July.

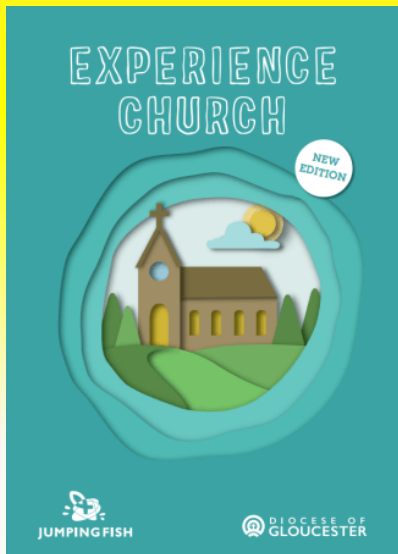
